FOR SEXUAL ABUSE AND SEXUAL HARASSMENT

RIGHT TO REPORT

If you, or someone you know, are experiencing sexual abuse or sexual harassment, Lincoln County Detention Center wants to know. We want you to report right away! Why?

- We want to keep YOU safe; it is our job! It is your right to be free from sexual abuse and sexual harassment.
- We want to conduct an investigation of the reported incident.
- We want to hold the perpetrator accountable for his/her actions.
- We want to provide YOU with relevant information and support services.

HOW TO REPORT

The Lincoln County Detention Center offers multiple ways to report sexual abuse and sexual harassment. Reports can be made anonymously.

- Report to any staff, volunteer, contractor, or medical or mental health staff.
- Dial *75 from an inmate phone. No PIN required. No charge.
- Submit a grievance or a sick call slip.
- Report to the PREA coordinator or PREA compliance manager.
- Call the Rape/Domestic Abuse Program 24/7 hotline at (308) 534-3495.
- Tell a family member, friend, legal counsel, or anyone else outside the facility. They can report on your behalf by calling (308) 535-3545.
- You also can submit a report on someone's behalf, or someone at the facility can report for you using the ways listed here.

VICTIM SUPPORT SERVICES

Lincoln County Detention Center shall provide medical and mental health support services as requested to any victim or perpetrator of sexual abuse.
